SAINT OF THE WEEK SAINT HILARY OF POITIERS

Saint Hilary was born at the beginning of the fourth century.

He was elected Bishop of Poitiers in 350. He fought strongly against Arianism and was exiled by the Emperor Constantius.

His works are full of wisdom and learning, directed to the strengthening of the Catholic faith and the right interpretation of Scripture.

He died in 367. He was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius IX in 1851.

Then write 20 + C + M + B + 25 in chalk over entrance doorway The letters C, M, B have two meanings. They are the initials of the traditional names of the three magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They also represent the Latin words "Christus mansionem benedicat" which means "May Christ bless the house." The "+" signs symbolize the cross and the 20 and the 25 represent the year.
