Cluster trip to Tyburn Convent – Monday 19th May 2025

For the Solemnity of Bl. Peter Wright this year, we are hoping to arrange a day of pilgrimage on Monday **19th May 2025** to Tyburn Convent, Hyde Park, London. Tyburn is the convent of the English martyrs and close to the location where Bl. Peter Wright himself was martyred.

The day will include being collected in the morning from points in our Cluster by minibus and taken to the convent where Father Benedetto will be able to say Mass for us. The sisters have offered us tea and coffee afterwards followed by a gentle tour lead by Tom Henry (a friend of the Convent) around some Catholic sites in London and driven back home around 5pm. There will be time for a packed lunch too.

At present we are only in the planning stage and trying to see if there is enough interest. As a guide, and from one quote we were given, if we have 15 people coming along it will work out around £40 per person. However, nothing is booked at the moment and that could change (to be cheaper) depending on the uptake.
